We were able to keep the prices the same as last year, and each order includes **free delivery** by a helpful, smiling neighbor!

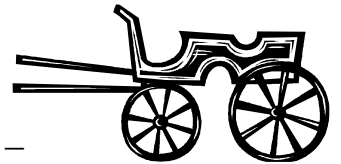

RECIPE CORNER



Submit your favorite recipes, and we can all get fat together!

OATMEAL RAISIN COOKIES

- | | |
|-----------------------|---------------------------------|
| 1 c. butter, softened | 2 t. cinnamon |
| 1 c. brown sugar | 1 t. baking soda |
| 3/4 c. sugar | 1/2 t. salt |
| 2 t. vanilla | 3 c. old-fashioned oats |
| 2 eggs | 1 1/2 c. raisins |
| 1 1/4 c. flour | 1 c. chopped walnuts (optional) |

- Beat butters, sugars, and vanilla at medium speed of electric mixer until light and fluffy.
- Add eggs, beat until well blended. Combine flour, cinnamon, baking soda, and salt
- Gradually add to butter mixture, mixing until well-blended. Stir in oats, raisins, and nuts.
- Drop dough by 1/4 cupfuls onto ungreased Airbake 14x16-inch baking sheet.
- Bake in preheated 350° oven 15 to 17 minutes, or until edges begin to brown. Let stand for 3 minutes before removing to cooling rack. Makes 2 dozen.
