## FRUIT SALSA

### Salsa

- 2 kiwis, peeled and diced
- 2 Golden Delicious apples, peeled, cored and diced
- 1 8 oz. pkg. raspberries, cut
- 1 lb. strawberries, cut
- 2 T. sugar
- 1 T. brown sugar
- 3 T. cherry jelly

### Tortilla Chips

- 10 10-inch Tortillas
- 2 c. cinnamon & sugar (2 c. sugar plus 4 t. cinnamon)
- Butter-flavored Pam

To make Salsa: In large bowl, combine fruit, sugars, and jelly; mix thoroughly. Cover and chill at least 15 minutes.

To make Chips: Preheat oven to 350°. Coat one side of each tortilla with cooking spray, sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar, and cut into wedges. Arrange in a single layer on a cookie sheet, bake 8 to 10 minutes. Allow to cool. Serve as you would chips & dip.
