### APPLE CRISP (A KIDS' RECIPE)

- |                     |                             |
|---------------------|-----------------------------|
| 4 large apples      | 1 teaspoon cinnamon         |
| 1/2 cup brown sugar | 1/4 teaspoon salt           |
| 1 cup flour         | 2 Tablespoons melted butter |
| 3/4 cup sugar       | 1 egg                       |

Have mom or dad preheat oven to 375°.

Peel, core, and slice apples. Put in bowl with 1/2 cup brown sugar.

In another bowl, mix 1 cup flour, 3/4 cup sugar, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, and 1/4 teaspoon salt.

Put 2 tablespoons butter into a measuring cup. Cook in microwave for 30 seconds, and then stir so that all butter is melted. Add 1 egg to butter and mix. Pour butter and egg mixture into flour mixture. Stir until crumbly.

Put apples into baking dish. Cover apples with crumbly topping.

Bake for 30 to 40 minutes at 375°.
