BACON-STUFFED TENDERLOIN STEAKS

8 slices bacon, cut into 1/2" pieces
 1/4 c. finely chopped onion
 1/2 c. cornbread stuffing mix
 1/2 c. water

4 6-oz. boneless beef tenderloin steaks, about 1 1/2" thick
 1 t. peppered season salt

Heat grill. Cook bacon in large skillet over medium heat until almost crisp. Reserve 1 T. drippings with bacon in skillet; set aside remaining drippings. Add onion to skillet, cook and stir 2 to 3 min. Add cornbread stuffing mix crumbs and water, mix well. Remove from heat.

With sharp knife, make pocket in side of each steak for stuffing. Spoon stuffing into each steak. Brush sides of each steak with reserved bacon drippings. Sprinkle each side with peppered season salt. Use toothpicks to hold together steaks if overstuffed, just remember to remove them prior to eating)

Place steaks on gas grill over medium heat or on charcoal grill 4 to 6 inches from medium coals. Cook 8 to 12 minutes or until of desired doneness, turning once.

RULES OF THE ROAD
