SECOND ANNUAL HANA NEIGHBORHOOD GARAGE SALE



FRI, MAY 19 • SAT, MAY 20 • SUN, MAY 21

Last year's garage sale seemed to be very successful and well-liked, and so back by popular demand is the now-annual Neighborhood Garage Sale!

Here's how it works:

- On Fri. May 19, Sat. May 20, and Sun. May 21, any family in the HANA neighborhood who wants to participate holds their own garage sale.
- You can participate on one day or all days, whatever you like. The time has been left open, but we suggest 9 am to 3 pm as a general guideline.

So what does HANA provide, you ask? Well, mostly coordination and advertising. HANA will be placing a nice ad in the Daily Herald Neighbor Classified section and possibly the Chicago Tribune (depending on expense).

We will also have details, maps, and directions on the HANA web site.

HANA will also place signage at key locations throughout the neighborhood and we're trying to work out a way to provide printed maps. We are also hoping to sign on Picket Fence Realty as a partner again this year.

HINTS & TIPS

- Start collecting stuff now. *Don't wait until the last minute.* Price it now, too!
- Don't have enough stuff? Combine with a neighbor. Make sure to mark stuff so you know whose is whose.
- Since HANA is not providing individual signs, it's up to you to make your sale visible to passers-by! Be creative: neon signs, flags on a string, balloons, banners, etc.
- Provide free water or let the kids sell lemonade or cans of cold soda from a cooler.
- Put your checkout table at the end of the driveway to discourage people from "forgetting" to pay. Also, do not put money in a cashbox - use a money apron or fanny pack. Put your calculator and cell phone in there, too.
- Save plastic bags from the grocery store for buyers to put their purchases in. If you are selling clothes, use dry cleaner hangers so the buyers can keep them.
- Go to your bank and get plenty of change beforehand. As a rule of thumb: (2) \$10, (4) \$5, (25) \$1, 1 roll each of quarters, nickels, and dimes.
- If you are selling anything electrical (lamps, radios, etc.), have a working extension cord or outlet strip so buyers can test to see if the item works.
- Soothing easy-listening or classical music can be very pleasant and invites buyers to linger.
- Finally - have fun, and gab with your neighbors!

SPINACH PARMESAN BACON BITES

| | |
|--|---|
| 2 10 oz. pkgs. frozen spinach, thawed | 1/3 c. Italian dry bread crumbs |
| 1/2 small red onion, finely chopped | 1/2 lb bacon, cooked and chopped (maple flavored is especially good) |
| 1/4 stick butter | 1 T. Worcestershire sauce |
| 2 eggs (3 if you want the square to be firmer) | 1/8 t. garlic, crushed |
| 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese + 3 T. reserved | Dash of salt and pepper |

Drain spinach in a strainer, removing all liquid. Reserve 1 cup of liquid.

Sauté onion in butter until tender.

In a bowl combine spinach, reserved liquid from spinach, sautéed onion mixture, eggs, 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese, bread crumbs, bacon, Worcestershire sauce, garlic, salt and pepper.

Spread into a 9x9 greased backing dish and sprinkle with a couple of tablespoons of Parmesan cheese. Bake uncovered at 350° for 30 minutes or until set.
