**PARK TOBACCO POLICY**

The Arlington Heights Park Board approved a new policy that prohibits the use of tobacco products in all Park District facilities, including buildings, outdoor pools, tennis courts, and skating areas. The policy also prohibits the use of tobacco products within

- 15 feet of any park facility entrance;
- 15 feet of playground equipment borders; and
- 50 feet of any outdoor facility, including baseball fields, soccer fields, basketball courts, and other fields.
