Rotating Appointments Approved by Board

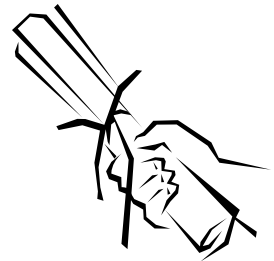

NEW FARMERS' MARKET LOCATION

Visit the VAH Farmers' Market at its new and more convenient location! Fresh produce is available every Saturday,

June 19 through Oct. 23, 7:30 am-1:30 pm, at the "S Parking Lot" on the corner of Vail Ave. and Fremont St. The new

location is south of the Arlington Heights Museum and west of the Arlington Heights Memorial Library.

GARDEN SPOTS AVAILABLE

Gardeners can rent a garden plot from the Arlington Heights Park District. The 25' x 30' plots are plowed, staked, and numbered. They are available to VAH residents for \$49.

Proof of residency is required and there's a limit of one plot per family.

VoAH_Waste_Study.pdf. The results are based on a public meeting where residents freely expressed their opin-

ions and completed a survey; an online survey; and randomly selected mail and telephone surveys.

CENSUS TAKERS VISIT VAH

Arlington Heights achieved an 82% response rate on the 2010 Census, which was the third highest response rate in Illinois for towns our size. During May and June, Census Takers will visit VAH homes that have not returned a cen-

sus form. Census Takers should carry official government badges marked with their name. They should not ask to enter your home.

Completing the Census directly benefits VAH residents

because it helps determine how federal money is allocated to our community. VAH receives revenue from the state based on our population count, which directly affects village services.
